

What To Do After a Car Crash



Stop your vehicle. Try to remain as calm as possible and take a deep breath, then do what you can -- within reason -- to avoid blocking the flow of traffic.



Call the police. Cooperate fully with the officer, but only give information that is necessary to explain the details of the accident. Never admit fault in any way.



Check to see if anyone is injured. Tend to any first-aid needs, but don't move anyone who is injured.



Call your insurance company and inform them of the accident. If an insurance adjuster shows up, **DO NOT** give any statements or sign anything.



Take notes. Get names, addresses and phone numbers of witnesses, making notes of what witnesses say happened.



Make sure to **get the other driver's license and insurance documentation** so that you can make sure the information you're getting is accurate.



Take pictures of the accident scene and damage to the vehicles.



Make an appointment and **visit your doctor** as soon as possible. The documentation your physician provides will be very important to your case.
